Day 2 (8 June) is also open to the public and includes oral presentations and visits to some of the wetlands at Ravlunda to search for dragonflies and diving beetles.



General information:

On site registration is compulsory and identification document is needed, since the seminar is held at a military exercise field. Registration will take place at Dammåkra.

During the excursion you need boots or gum boots. For late night excursion bring head light or flash lights. We also recommend to bring binoculars. Minivans will be used for transportation between sites during the excursions.

How to get there:

Public transportation: there are bus stops in Ravlunda. And then it is about 30 min walk to Dammåkra. On request we may be able to arrange pick-up in Ravlunda.
